
EULAC Museums participation (notice to use in social media and web platform):

As part of the 50th anniversary of the Declaration of Santiago Round Table and its commemoration programs, ICOM Chile in collaboration with Universidad Austral de Chile and the EULAC Museums and Community project, among others, organized a series of lectures on the museum's role in our societies to be held throughout October and November 2017 at the University of Concepción, Chile.
